The £500 million Criminal Records Bureau – 1998 to 2001

Led the implementation of Government Legislation in partnership with the UK Home Office and all 42 UK Police forces ensuring protection of the vulnerable in society

The £350 million London Congestion Charge – 2002 to 2003

Led the implementation of Transport for London scheme resulting in lower pollution levels and funding for the modernisation of London's transport systems and infrastructure

The £75 million Child Trust Fund – 2004 to 2005

Led the implementation of UK Government legislation with Her Majesties Revenue & Customs (HMRC) Department to provide starter savings for all UK Children encouraging life-long savings and reduction of poverty levels
